QUALIFICATIONS:

- Community Corner booths are only available to the following organizations:
 - Churches
 - Civic Organizations
 - Non-Profits (must attach IRS status to application)
 - Health/Wellness Organizations

Organizations listed above must attach a document that proves they are located in Newberry County or have listed in their mission statement that they serve Newberry County directly.

- The event reserves the right to reject applications that do not meet the values or standards of the event. This would be for selling, distributing, or displaying items of poor quality, inappropriate, or offensive nature. Our goal is to provide a quality experience for the vendor and patrons. Rejected applications will be returned with payment.
 - Community Corner Booths are for organizations to distribute community information, host bake sales, fundraise, etc. If you have questions about the approval of products your booth intends to sell or distribute, please contact the event organizer.
 - Community Corner Booths MAY NOT use their booth space for the sale of on or off-site cooked hot foods or foods that are considered Time/Temperature Control for Safety Foods per SCDHEC regulation 61-25 (<https://scdhec.gov/food-safety-timetemperature-control-safety-tcs-food>). Those interested in on-site cooking should consult our Food Court Vendor Application.

BOOTH SPACES:

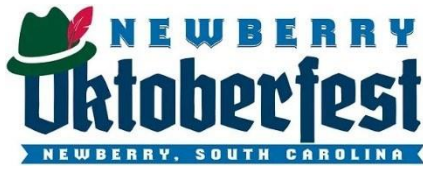
- Limited booth spaces are available (10 total 10x10 Spaces). Spaces are available after the panel reviews applications on a first-come-first-served basis.
- To accommodate a wider variety of vendors, only one space per vendor will be sold- **DOUBLE SPACES WILL NOT BE SOLD.**
- The Community Corner is located on Main Street between 1530 and 1511 Main Street (The Standard on Main and the Ritz Theater) and are **\$50**, Tents, tables, and chairs are **NOT** provided.
- Electricity is **not** available.
- We cannot assist with booth setup. Please make the necessary preparations to set up your booth.

TAXES & LICENSES: Vendors are responsible for collecting and reporting SC sales tax as required by law. Vendors are also responsible for obtaining a proper SC retail license from SCDOR as applies.

- Set-Up: 7:00 am-9:30 am and *Break Down: 6:00 pm-7:00 pm*Vendors are asked to remain open until the official breakdown period or be subject to application rejection for future Oktoberfest events.
- **RESCHEDULE DATE:** If an act of God forces the rescheduling of Oktoberfest, all approved vendors are expected to attend the rescheduled Oktoberfest Event date of October 18, 2025, from 10 am to 6 pm and NO refunds or credits will be issued to vendors.
- Checks **will** be returned if vendor approval is not granted.
